The inaugural 2014 STEM Expo was a huge success as the ASCE Central Ohio Section welcomed over 140 students. We are pleased to announce the 2nd Annual Central Ohio STEM Expo will be held on Saturday, February 28, 2015 at the Metro School from 9 AM to 1 PM. The event will again serve as a conclusion to Engineer's Week. Our goal is to expose students grades K through 8 to the world of Science, Technology, Engineering and Math through fun and interactive activities.

We are seeking local STEM professionals, educators, and organizations to serve as activity sponsors or exhibitors. Sponsoring an activity is easy and a great way to get involved in this educational outreach event. Activity sponsor responsibilities would include:

- Developing a fun, interactive STEM related activity;
- Obtaining funding through your employer for the activity materials, if necessary; and,
- Facilitating the activity at the STEM Expo event (typically 2-3 people needed).

A classic example of this type of activity would be the gumdrop and toothpick truss bridge. Activity sponsors should be prepared to accommodate between 150 and 250 students throughout the event, however usually not in groups of more that 5. Ideally, the activity would take students 10 to 20 minutes to complete.
