Topic: Main Street Bridge

Construction is underway for the new Main Street Bridge across the Scioto River in downtown Columbus. The bridge will e a unique structure having an inclined, single-rib tied arch. This structure will be the first of it's kind in the United States, and one of only a few in the world.

Mr. Siebert will present an overview of the design of this signature bridge and discuss several of its unique features. He will also share pictures of selected construction activities and artist renderings of the final bridge.

After the presentation, we will go outside and visit the site, which is right next door to COSI. Tom Graf with Kokosing and Jim Welter with ODOT will describe the project's construction. <u>Please wear appropriate</u> footwear and bring a hard hat if you have one.

15th Annual Great Lakes Geotechnical/Geoenvironmental Conference (GLGGC)

The Metropolitan Indianapolis Branch of ASCE will host the 2008 Great Lakes Geotechnical/Geoenvironmental Conference on Friday, May 9, 2008. Organized by The Geotechnical Group of the ASCE Metropolitan Indianapolis Branch this 15th annual conference will be on *Applications of Geotechnical Instrumentation for the Performance Evaluation of Constructed Facilities*.

Scope of the Conference

The field of geotechnical engineering has been considered largely to be an applied science fraught with uncertainty and potentially large consequences from unexpected performance of constructed facilities. Subsequently, the risks presented by these elements require control, and performance monitoring through the use of instrumentation is an essential tool for managing these risks. The 15th Annual GLGGC will provide a forum for presenting some of these applications. The emphasis will be towards the use of geotechnical instrumentation for performance monitoring.

Location

The conference will be held at The FOUNTAINS Banquet and Conference Center, which is located at 502 East Carmel Drive in Carmel, Indiana.
