Topic: City of Columbus - Water, Sewerage and Drainage Challenges

Tatyana Arsh, PE, is the Director of the City of Columbus Department of Public Utilities (including the Division of Power and Water and the Division of Sewerage and Drainage) and oversees an annual budget of \$550 million. Among many challenges, the City has embarked on a 40 year, \$5.5 billion project to eliminate sources of combined sewer overflows to the Scioto and Olentangy Rivers in the greater Columbus area. Ms. Arsh will provide an insight

on major activities of her department to date, and the challenges ahead.

CIVIL ENGINEERING PE REFRESHER COURSE


